Volunteer Obligations

Committee Members shall agree;

- To abide by the Constitution and By Laws of the State and District Association governing bodies and Hazelbrook Soccer Club Inc.
- To follow and encourage all members to abide by the Code of Conduct.
- Perform their duties with professionalism, objectivity, integrity and in the best interest of the Club at all times.
- Respect the rights dignity and worth of others regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Should perform any duties associated with their position skilfully, diligently and impartially and to the best of their ability in order to contribute to the effective and efficient management of Hazelbrook Soccer Club Inc.
- Ensure the process by which this organisation is made, is to be responsive to the rights and wishes of its members.
- To perform their official duties with care and diligence and agree to act in a fair and unbiased manner always ensuring their behaviour enhances the reputation and public understanding of the Club.
- Are expected to act within the law, be honest and fair.
- Not act unreasonably, unjust, oppressively or in a discriminatory manner.
- Appreciated that members, players, parents and affiliated organisations have rights and aspirations. They must be treated with dignity, respect and sensitivity to their rights.
- To encourage and support all members to interact towards each other in a mutually supportive and respectful manner.

- Observe confidentiality in respect of all information gained through your participation.
- To sign and submit a Working with Children's Check once elected for their position.
- To forward yearly feedback regarding position portfolio and complete evaluation forms to the Management Committee. These will enable the committee to assess budget, objectives, goals and obligations of their position for the forthcoming season.
- Accept and follow directions from the Management Committee and seek guidance through clarification where you may be uncertain of tasks or requirements. Familiarise with policies and guidelines on particular issues.
- Observe safe work practices.

- Use or disclose restricted information without authority, other than for official purposes in the performance of their duties.
- Use the Club to seek or obtain any financial advantage for themselves or any other person or organisation.
