Drug Free Policy

The Hazelbrook Soccer Club recognises the need to ensure that all participants are educated about medications and other drugs, in order to prevent or reduce potential harm.

The health and safety of all participants is our primary concern.

The key to preventing and reducing drug related harm is to have a co ordinated plan that involves the education of participants and implementation of appropriate procedures.

The development of a workable drug free policy is an essential outcome of a risk assessment evaluation for Hazelbrook Soccer Club.

We will actively seek to promote, encourage and support strategies to prevent or reduce harm from drug use for all members.

Where possible Hazelbrook Soccer Club Inc. will:

Safe Drug Use Practices.

- Educate participants through the delivery of drugs in sport information at courses conducted by our organisation or association.
- Discourage the use of medications in respect of injury recovery that would enable a participant to compete where they would not otherwise have been able to.
- Strongly encourage the promotion that venues and activities are drug free.
- Provide appropriate education for participants as to the potential harm of using prohibited or banned substances.
- Ban the use of illegal drugs at all club activities.
- Not allow the participants under the influence of drugs to participate in training or competition matches in order to prevent harm to themselves and other participants.
